i) Essential Qualification:

1. First Class Masters Degree in Business Management / Administration / in a relevant management related discipline or first class in two year full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU / accredited by AICTE / UGC.
2. Qualifying the NET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment. However the candidates, who have been awarded a Ph. D degree in accordance with UGC (minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph. D Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility conditions of NET for recruitment of Assistant Professor.

ii) Desirable:

1. Teaching, research, industrial and/or professional experience in a reputed organization.
2. Papers presented at Conferences and / or published in refereed journals.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- i) IITTM requires the faculty position in the discipline of Tourism & Travel/ International Business/ Events Management/ Tourism & Cargo/ Tourism & Leisure/ Services. The preference will be given to the candidate having education and teaching experience in the field/ domain as mentioned on pre page and their publications should also be in the same field.
- ii) Preference shall also be given to the candidates with tourism and Travel Management as their specialization as well as experience in handling central govt. tourism related projects.
- iii) In the institutions where grading system is followed, applicants are required to convert the grade obtained by them into its equivalent percentage giving the standard conversion formula.
- iv) Aspirants are advised to satisfy themselves before applying for the post that they possess at least the minimum essential qualification as laid down in the advertisement/IITTM website.
- v) The aspirants for the job of Assistant Professor in IITTM are required to submit their applications with completed **Datasheet** based on data, as on the last/closing date of receipt of applications. The applicant should submit 3 sets of 5 major publications that have been published subsequent to their placement in the post of Assistant Professor Stage-II. A certificate about the date of placement in Assistant Professor stage-II issued by the competent authority of their organization must be attached with the application.
- vi) The Mere possession of the essential qualifications will not entitle the aspirant to be called for test/ interview. IITTM, at its discretion, may restrict the number of aspirants to a reasonable limit, on the basis of higher qualifications/experience than the minimum as prescribed in the advertisement.
- vii) Certificate in support of experience of the aspirant should be in a proper format i.e. it should be on the organization's letter-head, the date of issue, specific period of work, name and designation of issuing authority along with signature and official seal.
- viii) Relaxation in educational qualification, experience, age, etc. in the case of reserved category aspirants will be applied as per Government of India regulations.

- ix) Aspirants belonging to SC/ST category must submit the reservation certificate issued by the competent authority, not below the rank of Tahsildar. In the case of OBC candidate, recent certificate should be issued by the competent authority particularly with reference to Non-creamy layer. Those who fail to submit the required certificate(s) latest by the last date of application will be treated to be a General Category candidates, subject to fulfillment of other terms & conditions.
- x) The Aspirants applying under PWD Category are required to submit the Disability Certificate issued by the competent authority in the format prescribed by Government of India for this purpose.
- xi) No TA/DA shall be paid to the Aspirants for attending the written test/interview.
- xii) IITTM can verify the antecedents as well as documents submitted by aspirant before or at the time of appointment or during the tenure of service. In case of submission of any fake document, false information, clandestine antecedents or suppression of material information, services of the incumbent in the IITTM shall be terminated forthwith.
- xiii) In case of any inadvertent mistake detected in the process of selection after the issue of appointment, IITTM reserves the right to modify/withdraw/cancel any offer of appointment made to the Aspirant in the case of selection.
- xiv) The Application form as per the prescribed format may be created or downloaded in **A-4** size paper from IITTM website www.iittm.ac.in.
- xv) The last date for receiving of completed applications and crucial date for calculation of essential qualification & experience is **28th February, 2019**. No application will be entertained after the last date prescribed for receipt of applications.
- xvi) Aspirants are advised to submit their applications well in time and do not wait till the last date of application. The IITTM will not be responsible for any postal delay etc. and no correspondence or telephonic/electronic query will be entertained from Aspirants regarding postal delay, conduct and result of interview and reasons for not being called for interview. Canvassing directly or indirectly at any stage of the recruitment process will lead to disqualification.

- xvii) Aspirants those already in service may submit their applications **through proper channel along with their PBAS score certified by a Group-A level Officer**. An advance copy of the application could be sent directly before the prescribed last date of submission of applications, and in that case, a No Objection Certificate (NOC) will need to be produced at the time of written test/interview.
- xviii) IITTM reserves the right not to fill any of the post(s). There could be an increase or decrease in the number of posts up to the date of completion of recruitment process.
