

Syllabus for Admission Entrance Test (IIAT)

A. General Awareness – 50%.

The general awareness section shall consist of 100% objectives type questions with the following distributions:

25% general awareness MCQs based on tourism which consist of national level tourism, state level tourism, travel and tourism literature, types of tourism, local level tourism, travel modes, road infrastructure and accessibility.

25% General awareness MCQs based on general current affairs.

B. Verbal Ability – 25%

To assess language proficiency, comprehensive, communication skills and vocabulary.

C. Quantitative Ability – 25%

To assess numerical aptitude, data interpretation and basic mathematical skills.

Additionally, a descriptive question may be included seeking admission to the institute.
